


Pirac	y defined under UNCLOS article101 as	
a)	Any illegal acts of violence or detention, or any act of depredation, committed for private ends by the crew or the passengers of a private Armed Robbery defined under IMO resolution A.1025 (26)	
	ship or a private aircraft, and directed:- a) Any illegal act of violence or determine or any act of depraydation	
i)	On the high seas, against another ship or aircraft, or against persons or property on board such ship or aircraft and directed against a ship or against persons or property onboard such an anact of piracy, committed for private ends and directed against a ship or against persons or property onboard such a	
ii)	Against a ship, aircraft, persons or property in a place outside the jurisdiction of any State	
b)	Any act of voluntary participation in the operation of a ship or of an aircraft with knowledge of facts making it a pirate ship or aircraft.







